### PROJECT UPDATE- JUNE 2023

If you have recently visited Churchill Way you may have noticed some exciting new developments. The team have completed all the necessary steelwork for both the footbridges, which on completion will enable pedestrians to walk from one side of the canal to the other. The steelwork is also in place for the cantilever stage.

We have started capping the tops of the concrete walls that surround the canals and installed a new water feature.

We are making progress with our rain garden, urban drainage system with fitted specialised kerbs that will catch excess rainwater.

Over the past month we have installed new traffic lights on Adams Street, Churchill Way and Bute Terrace and completed the white line work. Adams Street is now open, introducing the ability for vehicles to turn right onto Churchill Way.

We completed works on one side of Station Terrace, North Edward Street to Newport Road. and installed a range of pre-moulded kerbs in Dumfries Place.

We will be starting works on the opposite side of the road on Station Terrace spanning from Steak of the Art restaurant to the Spar shop and continuing development of rain gardens.
